

## Estate Red Mountain Chardonnay

From Red Mountain's pioneering vineyard planted in 1975. Crisp Chardonnay fruit characteristics with a rich, toasty complexity from careful oak treatment.

**About the Wine** – White varietals are not widely planted on Red Mountain, making this Estate Chardonnay a unique expression of the AVA. This classic Burgundian-styled wine is fermented right in the barrel, lending a layered richness and nuance to our already outstanding Red Mountain fruit.

**Tasting Notes** – Pronounced minerality, tart acidity, and fresh green fruit notes are framed by a kiss of French oak. Small amounts of Roussanne and Viognier are blended in to enhance the nose and fatten up the mid-palate. Try this exceptional wine with salads or seafood, especially dungeness crab, sole, or grilled halibut.

### Selling Points
