Estate Red Mountain Merlot

“Cooling basil and mint, roasted tomato, toasted nuts and freshly ground coffee intrigue the nose, then combine with a juicy if discreet sense of red berry fruit on a polished palate. This spent two years in 60% new barrels, but the influence of the latter is remarkably restrained and the protracted finish is anything but dried out. It should prove deliciously versatile for at least the next 2-3 years, though in no way does it demand cellaring. “
