VINEYARD PROFILE

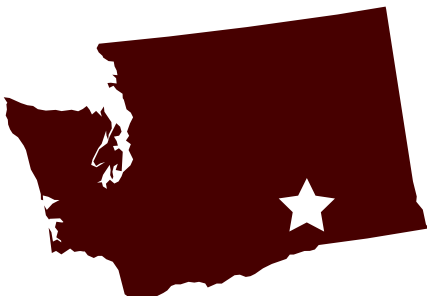
Riesling grows exceptionally well in the Columbia Valley, where big temperature swings and ample sunlight ensure nice ripening and vibrant acidity. We have found multi-vineyard Rieslings to be the most interesting from our region, which is why we supplement our own plantings with sourced fruit from nearby Willard and Holten vineyards.

WINE PROFILE

Crisp, clean, and refreshing, this Riesling showcases the bright acidity and tremendous fresh fruit characteristic that has helped Washington establish a reputation as a world-class producer of the varietal. A small Gewürztraminer addition adds depth, sweetness, aromatics, and intrigue. We cold-ferment to preserve fruit flavors and capture a small amount of frizzante in every bottle.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2015 vintage was one of the warmest on record in Washington. Flavors and sugars developed rapidly, producing wines with lots of power and depth. Most varietals were picked ahead of schedule.
